Author evenings - Book Talks - engagement with community

Yorketown SCL study assistance for unemployed: one unemployed man studying social sciences currently in year three

Farmer – Broadband- Stock prices- local library to check prices

Community – check stock market - disabled gentleman we check his shares weekly – same time each week at Millicent

BUT library is not just a place for education

Critical place for social networking - third place

- Community have more contact with library staff than anywhere else in community
